The proxy need not be a member of the Company but he/she must attend the AGM in person to represent you. ANY ALTERATION MADE TO THIS FORM OF PROXY MUST BE INITIALLED BY THE PERSON(S) WHO SIGN(S) IT.
- 4. IMPORTANT: IF YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR A RESOLUTION, TICK THE BOX MARKED "FOR". IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST A RESOLUTION, TICK THE BOX MARKED "AGAINST". Failure to tick either box will entitle your proxy to cast your vote or abstain at his/her discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote or abstain at his/her discretion on any amendment to the resolutions referred to in the notice of the AGM which has been properly put to the AGM.
- 5. This form of proxy must be signed by the appointor or his attorney duly authorised in writing or, if such appointor is a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person authorised to sign on that behalf.
- 6. Any member entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint another person as his/her proxy to attend and vote instead of him/her. A Shareholder of the Company who is the holder of two or more Shares may appoint more than one proxy to represent him/her and vote on his/her behalf at the AGM. A proxy need not be a Shareholder of the Company but must attend the AGM to represent you.
- 7. In order to be valid, this form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed, or a notarially certified copy of such power or authority, shall be delivered to the office of the Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office, Tricor Investor Services Limited at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM (i.e. Wednesday, 21 August 2024 at 11:30 a.m.) or adjourned meeting (as the case may be) at which the person named in this form proposes to vote.
- 8. Delivery of this form of proxy shall not preclude a member from attending and voting in person at the AGM convened and in such event, this form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- 9. Where there are joint registered holders of any Shares, any one of such persons may vote at the AGM, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such Share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the AGM personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register of members of the Company in respect of such Share shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- 10. The notice of the AGM is set out in the Company's circular dated 25 June 2024.
- 11. Members of the Company or their proxies shall produce documents of their proof of identity when attending the AGM.
